



**AGREEMENT OF MUTUAL COOPERATION**  
*Between*  
**SWEDENBIO**  
*And*  
**Swedish American Chamber of Commerce San Diego**

Here under referred to as "Both Parties"

Having taken into consideration the desire to contribute in mutual cooperation between **SwedenBIO** and **Swedish American Chamber of Commerce – Life Science Bridge Initiative** in the field of life sciences.

Both parties have reached the following understanding:

1. Both Parties shall encourage within their possibilities and competence mutually advantageous economic and scientific cooperation between the Swedish life science industry and the life science cluster of San Diego, including the regulatory and financial actors.
2. Both Parties shall exchange information on possibilities for market research, invest- and partnering meetings, and trade missions organized in their countries and shall transmit this information to their members as well as promote the formation of networks between the Swedish life science industry and the one of San Diego.
3. Both Parties shall enable strategic advice to be offered to members of the respective organizations. This can be related to regulations, the financial landscape etc. as well as informing about policy makers intentions and decisions.

4. Both Parties shall facilitate for delegations with the aim to enable discussions on cooperation between companies and universities of their country/state.
5. Both Parties shall render each other marketing assistance, for instance through newsletters, social channels and webb, for organization symposiums, forums as well as other events aimed at the promotion of further development of life sciences industry between their countries.
6. Each parties' members shall have access to the same member benefits regarding events and courses with subject to availability.
7. Members of the respective organizations could, if conditions permit, gain temporary access to the physical meeting infrastructure of the respective organization.
8. Other co-operative activities mutually agreed upon on a case-to-case basis.
9. Both parties shall refer to respective organizations' membership, in an attempt to assist each other in the recruitment of new members.
10. This Agreement becomes effective on the date of signing and shall be valid for an unlimited period of time unless six months' notice of the intention to terminate the Agreement is given by either party.
